

When attending a performance, the following rules of courtesy should be observed by all audience members:

- Wear appropriate attire.
- Follow rules of the facility.
- Be attentive; refrain from talking and making inappropriate noises.
- Sit and become quiet when light or sound signals are given for performances.
- Remain quiet and seated during performances. (If necessary to leave the auditorium, do so between musical selections.)
- Watch the conductor during a musical performance and applaud when appropriate.
- Walk; do not run in performance halls.
- Turn all electrical devices off or to silent mode during a performance.
- Avoid chewing gum and consuming food and drink during a performance.
